1. What is the mission statement of your organization?
2. Explain how this program fits our 2011 Funding Statement.
3. Summarize how the proposed grant will impact our community. Include the number of persons who will benefit from this programming.
4. Write a brief narrative outlining your proposed program. Please include potential collaborative efforts with other organizations.
5. List other potential sources of funding for this program.

Submit an electronic copy of all requested materials to the Community Foundation by **October 25, 2010**. Electronic copies may be submitted to kristys@cfwcmd.org. During the review process, you may be asked to provide additional information. *Previous grantees that have not provided required reporting documentation may be ineligible for additional grants.*

In the event grant is awarded, organization will be required to provide proof of 501(c) (3) status, as well as a detailed budget of the proposed program. Recipients will be required to include the Community Foundation in all publicity regarding the grant and the program. The Community Foundation will notify all applicants of the outcome of their proposals by February 1, 2011 with funds to be distributed in full or in increments shortly thereafter.
